

5. Also a Town Way from M^r Jonathan Griffy's Corner, running Southwesterly into the way by M^r Eliab Moors North Corner, formerly M^r John Adams's, as set forth in the Minits of S^d Way.

6. To See if the Town will mend their High Ways by a Rate the Year ensuing as they did the Year past, and Appoint the Surveyors to be Collectors of S^d Rate or Tax, and grant Money for the same, and order any thing farther with respect to the mending of their high ways as the Town shall think best when met.

7. To See if the Town will appropriate so much of their unappropriated Money if there be a Sufficiency to pay their Town Treasurer & Assessors for their Service the Year ensuing.

8. To See if the Town will Order where the line shall be between the Constables Wards in S^d Town.

9. To See if the Town will Accept of the Report of the Selectmen with respect to their Accounting with their late Town Treasurers.

10. To See if the Town will build or provide a Work house in S^d Town that Idle & disorderly People may be properly employed; and Choose a Committee for that purpose. — And make due Return to the Selectmen at time & place above mentioned.
