- 8 Voted By y^e Town that a fine of Two Shillings be Laid upon the owner or owners of any Dog or dogs that shall Come & Make any Disturbance at either of y^e Meeting Houses in said y^e Sudbury on y^e Lord or Sabbath day on y^e half of y^e fine to Be to the Complainer and the other to the poor of y^e town y^e year ensuing Voted that Esq^r Browne or Capt. Richardson present to Date to the General Sessions of the Peace at their s^eling this Instant March L. B. Capt. Richardson. Thomas to Carry to Date to y^e Sessions for Confirmation Without any Cost to y^e town
