 - 2 Then D Town Chose Ephraim Curtis Esq. Moderator
 - 3 Voted at D meeting By D Town that y^e Swine In D Go at Large y^e year

- at D meeting it was By y^e Votes of D Town Granted to the Several Persons here
after Named to them their heirs and assigns the Several Pieces of Land and

 - 2 To Peter Noyes in y^e East 30 Rod way in y^e New grants so Called about 2 acres
at 2-13-4 P^r acre his Bond is 5-6-8
 - 3 To James Mosman about half an acre within his fence and about 30 acre
in y^e East 30 Rod way so Called a town way Parting D Land Near n^o Balcorn
at 0-4-0 P^r acre his Bond is 6-2-0
 - 4 To Aaron Hayes about 7 acres in y^e East 30 Rod way at 0-13-4 P^r acre
also about 3 acres & 100 Rods in y^e East 30 Rod way at 3 dollars for y^e whole his Bond is 5-11-4
 - 5 To Zephaniah Smith about 15 acres Near his house in the west 30 Rod way
at 0-17-4 P^r acre his Bond is 19-2-8
 - 6 To Henry Smith in y^e Middle highway about 20 acres Near his house on

as set forth in y^e Seventh Article in y^e order for D meeting
also D Town By their Votes ordered y^e Assessors forthwith to Assess y^e Town in y^e Sum.
Granted for preparing y^e highways at their meeting in March next.
- Also it was Put to Vote to see if y^e Town would Consider what they did by March
meeting Last with respect to y^e Drift way laid out through Capt. Seagers Land to Attorneys
