The select men of this town understanding that Andrew Cook of Dunstable had disorderly entered into our town with his wife and family and not only so: but had also brought in his father and mother in law a ruggle of very antient persons weak and feeble and very likely to become a burthen unto this town: whoare upon not sent for said Cook and did admonish him and warn him that with in fourteen days in suing this date said Cook should either remove our town of said father and mother or els bring such security to the select men as they should excoyt or ell the town may expert to be dole with all as y^e law in y^e case doth direct

December y^e 13: 1697 Mr Edmond Cof of rambredg Esq^r is a meeting and made these proposals unto us for as much as there is a legacy given y^e town of Sudbury by y^e deceased Mr Edmond Brown late pastor of y^e church of Sudbury deceased. Said Cof desired that said dole should be with a truly paid and in order ther unto desired that y^e town of Sudbury should appoint and constitute some parson to be the towns lawfull attorney in that name to sue said Cof and said Cof doth Inquering to save y^e town of Sudbury harmless from all cost and charge in y^e law as may any m^y tryale of y^e case ~~admitted~~ and the principall will and truly payd unto y^e town of Sudbury as witness my hand select men in y^e behalf of y^e town

At a select mens meeting y^e day and yeare above writon voted ordered and agreed yt Mr Joseph Shorman ^{of watertown} is appointed and constituted the towns of Sudburys lawfull attorney in y^e name and in the name stood to sue Mr Samuell Cof of rambredg and Mr John Joloff of Boston the surviving Executors of Mr Edmond Brown last will and testament of late pastor of the Church of Sudbury deceased for a legacy of fifty pounds given by y^e said Brown to y^e town of Sudbury and present said Suto to full effect) Select men in y^e name of the town
