discreetly largely and Convincing arguments and witness to evince the truth
and realoty: of the matter under Contest which is as followeth
In pursuance of your order bearing date the 7th of October 1697 to vnto
between Capt Brown and the meadow belonging to ye minister and all the said
place on ye ninth the day of this Instant October wee underwritten being
informed by testimony on the place to our satisfaction that ye
between Capt Brown and the ministeriall meadow vnto two rods norward of
a whit oak on ye East Side of the river and is extended across ye
to aky way on the other side and to a pole standing in Capt Goodenows
dithe therefore Reason to state ye lyne theare in the afore said place
presenting ye same for your Confirmation remaining your humbl servants
