 made by which was taken August y^e 22. 1699 excepting p^rols
 the day and year first written voted that the select men make me James
 Sharmen's rate of 42.10 according to former Covenant which is now due
 At the same time granted to Benj more and Joseph Stanhop twenty shill
 in contry pay if money a third part buted for y^e killing of a wolf
