Sudbury April 3rd 10th at a generall Town meeting leagely w^{or}nd voted and agreed Corp^s with Correll Tho Ruter for to sweep the meeting house and ring the Ruter bell for the present yeare and or the ^{time} performence of it he is to have for Shillings in money paid him by the Town

The Town rat The day and yeare above written it was voted that y^e Select men ^{make} a money rate of ~~thirteen~~ ^{thirteen} pound twelve ^{shilling} to pay the Towns Dapts

poor At a Town meeting leagely w^{or}nd voted that the Town ownd Jonathan Correll and Deborah w^{or}ge to be the poor of the Town of Sudbury to be taken care of by the Select men or over Seers of the poor as the Land direct at the Towns Charge

At a meeting of the Selectmen may y^e 7: 1700 the Towns rate of thirteen pound twelve shillings of money for the paym^{en}t of the Towns Dapts was made and delievered to the Constable Mr Hopstel Browne. Mr John Brewer to gather and pay into the Towns Treasurer

Mr At a Town meeting leagely w^{or}nd october the 30th 1700 Sharmos voted that Mr Sharmons half yeare Rat shall be made according to foremer Covenant which be come due the Last of august 1700

the select men At a Town meeting leagely w^{or}nd october y^e 30th 1700 men to make voted that the select men shall make Mr Sharmons half yeare Rate which is be come due

parsons At a Town meeting leagely w^{or}nd october y^e 30th 1700 not paying voted that those parsons that dont pay or neglect to the Constable there Rat or proportion to Mr Sharmon that is now to feed it in to be made by the Last of ^{March} 1700 the Constable have full power to feed it in and those parsons shall pay the Constable for his trouble and Charge
