Also the above said meeting the th town Chose M^r William Brown M^r Thomas Plymton to go and get the M^r masters to strengthen there Surtificat to get of our fine if it may be

Also the above said meeting the town voted and past into an act that the select men should get a notation writ to send to the General Court to get of our fine if it may be

Forwrd of the select men of Sudbury forty Shillings upon the Account of the gallery due to me from the town I say Forwrd by me Nathaniel Pitcher May 25 1702

Also the above sd meeting the town voted and past into an act that the select men should forthwith go and make fine bonds to pay the fine pounds fine that was sent for by the Authority
