

At a town Meeting June 15th 1702 M^r Nathaniell
Pitcher Expected to be our Schoolmaster for 3 quarters of a
year yet to come: Also at the same Meeting the town
Agreed by a vote that the School should be kept at the Meeting
house half a quarter and the other half quarter at the house of
Benjamin Morfos

June 15th 1702

- Also the town Treasurer Deaton King gave the town in an
Account of the town Tax put into his hands to pay town debts ^{with a} 1701
which a Count was Expected by the Selectmen and town
- Gudbury September the 11th 1702 at a town Meeting legally warned
the town Chose M^r Joseph Noyes Moderator
- The town voted and agreed that the Schoolmaster the next half quarter
of a year six weeks should keep school in the Meeting house
- 2^{ly} voted that the school houses formerly voted should be built by a general
town rate
- 3^{ly} voted and agreed that the Selectmen should make rate as Money of
20 pounds for the Erecting of the School houses formerly agreed upon
- 4^{ly} voted that there should only be two schoolhouses Erected one by Craglands
And the other New vote Robert Mans house as formerly ordered
- 5^{ly} voted and agreed that only four Men should be a Committee to oversee the
works of or for the building of the said School houses 2 on each side of
the River, Namely Mr Joseph Cleason for East side of River
And Mr John Brigham Thomas Smith for the west side of y^e River
- 6^{ly} voted those men that have a weeks warning by sd overseers of the fore
mentioned work doo not come to work accordingly to there warning
should paye such rates the overseers shall want for the carrying on
of the work of building of y^e sd Schoolhouses: atest Joseph Noyes Moderator

At a Town Meeting legally warned August the 11th 1702
voted that the town vote send in a petition to the generall Court
Concerning our River Meadows that are much Damified by
Persons of many Stoxages that the generall Court vote discharge
us of our tax or choos a Committee to see if it may be kept
the petition to be send in the name of the town

2^{ly} The town voted the above sd meeting to Chuse Men to take an
Inventorie all over the town of woods and all Rateable Estate

3^{ly} Voted the same meeting and Chose men to take an inventorie
two on each side of the River M^r Joseph Noyes for East side of y^e River
Leason on y^e East side of y^e River and Jos Hoxstall Brown on
the West side of the River
