from keeping of school which a month to the 15th of the next of time

Also voted and agreed as a free will to give unto Mr Pitcher two
days in Every quarter of his year to visit his friends if he so long
to take up with it

Also voted that the ways shall be wear the Community have brought
in there Judgment and Report to the town where it is most
Convenient and beneficial for the towns use

Also voted the day above writen that the Selectmen shall make
Mr James Shermans halfe years Rate last past and now due
March first 1703 the above days transactions
