to go about his Consoners somtimes provided he shall make up the time
and serve the town from all fines for sporting a schoolmaster for this
present yeare voted also that he shall have his first quarters salary
abough the later end of June next ensuing and so added to the towns Rate
to be gathered with the s^d Rate by the Constable

April the sixteenth 1703 Samuell King by is Chooser our Commissioner
by a loyall vote of the town to goyn with the select men to tacked

Samuell How to put in a new good flock into the boll that soit
may hang well and like wise to mend the long backe seats
of the meeting house and to naille the loose Clabords and to
Mend the Northeast Corner sell the works so done he then
to bring in his account to the town and to be payd the next town
Rate
