In pursuance of a precept bearing date April 29 1704: You are Required in His Majesty's Name to warn y^e freeholders and other inhabitants of y^e Town of Sudbury Qualify as y^e Law Directs to meet and assemble at y^e meeting house on Monday y^e 22 of This instant May at seven of y^e Clock in y^e forenoon Then and there to chuse a Repⁿ and Depute one Mod^r parson Being a freeholder and Resident in this town to serve for and Represent them in a great and general Court or assembly appointed to be convened hold and kept for her Majesties service at y^e Town house in Boston upon Wednesday y^e thirty first day of this instant May: and also to Consider Running of y^e line with Benjamin Wight about his homestead lands and y^e Common land upon Complaint of Sam^l concerning him y^e said Benjamin Wight and also to give order if y^e Town Books may be put into y^e hand of y^e Town Clerk By order of y^e select men Richard Moore Town Clerk
