which I have to a Negro Slave Named Tobe which is Mine I the said
John Winch Do fully & Absolutely Manumite Discharge & fully set
free & for my self my heirs Exors & Adors Do Prohonne &
Declare that the said Tobe is Absolutely a free Man & fully set
at Liberty from all Slavery what soever from by or under
me In witness whereof I the said John Winch have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this 30th Day of October A: D: 1749
& In y^e 23: year of his Majestys reign
