1. To bring in Town Debts and Credit.
2. To see if the Town will Grant to Each of their Reverant ministers any Honourable Gratuity for the year Enueing including their Salary Fire wood and Grattuity
3. To see if the Town will provide a Grammar for the year Enueing and order where said shall be kept
4. To see if the Town will Grant money for the support of the Grammar school
5. To see if the Town will Grant money for the support of Reading and writing schools for the year Enueing and order where said schools shall be kept in said Town
6. To see if the Town will appoint men to take care of each meeting house and sweep them this Enueing: And Dig Graves as there may be occasion
7. To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their assessors and Town Treasurer for their services
8. To Grant money to Repair the meeting Houses in said Town
9. To see if the Town will order their Treasurer Mr. Parris to Call in the Interest money Due on several Bonds given for the purchase of Land for the new Grant Land so called for the Towns use
10. To see if the Town will order their Treasurer Mr. Parris to Call in the money from the Constables which they have Gathered from the severall parsons that paid their money instead of working out their highway Rates and to pay those surveyors that have over worked their the Town has Granted them the money

11. To see if the Town will Grant to the severall parsons here after named to them their application for Ever the severall pieces of Land and Swamp Ground as they have a Gred with the Town Committee for (to wit) Ephraim Curtis. Thomas Damon & Jonathan Smith and order the same be Recorded as a Gred for as they are Bounded in the severall plans of the same at the purchase
Brown 15 acres in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant at four shillings an acre - 3-0
Knight 13 acres & a quarter at three shillings per acre in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant at 1-10
Reynolds Sea for about 20 acres in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant at 0-6-8 an acre - 6-13
William about 3 acres in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant at 1-8-0 an acre - 4-0
Hayes 2 acres & 62 Rod in the East 30 Rod wide way at 0-4-0 an acre in the new Grant - 0-9
Smith about an acre within his old field fence near his house for - 0-7
each head about 20 acres at 1-0-0 an acre in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant - 20-0
at of Bon about 15 acres at 0-8-0 an acre in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant - 6-0
Brigham about 15 acres at 0-6-0 an acre in the East 30 Rod wide way in the new Grant - 4-10
The Town will pass a vote to Defend the Towns Title to the severall parsons as they have a Gred or said Committee for as they are Granted to them in case any parson or parsons shall dispute their title to them in the Law. If proper and reasonable application be made to the Town Committee before said Committee but if they neglect to make application as afore said then the Town be freed from any cost to

To order their Town Treasurer to Receive the money or Bonds for the afore said Grant of the afore said Committee for the Towns Use from time to time as the Town shall order
The Town will grant a Sum of money to Enable the Towns Committee to prosecute a writ of Ejectment against some parson or parsons holding of land which is belonging to the said Town in the thirty Rod highway so called at the corner of Capt. Reynolds Seager Capt. John Hayes & others
