adjourned their meeting to Friday the sixth day of March Current to meet at the same place at one of the Clock after Noob to finish the work of Meeting &c

at Josiah Richardson Moderator

March 5th 1756

the Town being met according to the aforesd. Adjourned. Proceeded to the work of the Day &c

The Town by a vote accepted of Mr Asher Culler to serve as stable in the room of Mr Nath^l Rice

The Town also by a vote accepted of Mr Phineas Haynes to serve as Constable in the room of Mr Wm Rice

they were chose Constables by the Town of Sudbury at their meeting March 1st 1756

A vote was call to see if the Town would give leave, that Hogs might go at large any part of the time between the first day of April & the 1st of November the ensuing year and it passd in the Negative

at said meeting they accepted of the list of Jurors that were put in the nose

A vote was call to see if the Town would give leave, that sheep might go at large at any part of the time from the first day of March to the first day of April and it passd in the Negative

The Town by a vote accepted of Mr Sam^l Willis place and gave leave that it might be recorded
