their Representative for the ensuing Year. Capt John Roby Esq.
a Freeholder & Resident in S^d Town
At s^d Meeting May 14th The Town Proceeded & chose Ebenezer Roby
Esq^r Moderator.
- 2^d The Article relating to a Lottery was put to Vote & passed in the
Negative
- 3^d Voted by S^d Town that the swine in S^d Town go at large
the ensuing Year.
- 4th The Articles contained in the Petition, concerning the New
Grant High Ways, were all put to Vote and passed in the
Negative
- 5th The Town by their Vote granted the Petition of Joseph Tower
of one pound fourteen shillings & eight pence Lawful money
to pay Doctor Perkins for his Doctoring Edward Joyner and
his Family in their Sickness

on Friday the twenty Ninth Day of October Currant, at twelve
o Clock, at Noon, then & there.

- 1st To Bring in Town debts & Credit.
- 2^d To See if the Town will Grant their New Ministers an Honourable
gratuity for the Year ensuing, including their Salary & Firewood.
- 3^d To see if the Town will provide a Grammar Schoolmaster and
Order where the School shall be kept the ensuing Year, and Give
for the Support of the Same.
- 4th To see if the Town will Grant money for the support of the Reading
and Writing Schools & order where s^d Schools, shall be kept the
ensuing Year.
- 5th To see if the Town will accept of the Settlement made between the
Selectmen & the Town Treasurer, Mr Samuel Parris.
- 6th To see if the Town will appoint a Man or Men to take Care of
and sweep each of the meeting Houses in Said Town the Year ensuing
and dig Graves as there may be Occasions.
- 7th To see if the Town will grant money to repair the High ways
in S^d Town the Year ensuing.
- 8th To see if the Town will grant money for the relief of the Poor
S^d Town the Year ensuing.
- 9th To see if the Town will grant money, for to finish the Repairing
the Meeting Houses in S^d Town.
