

Sudbury November 7th 1756

The Town being met, at time & place, according to the aforesaid Adjournment, they proceeded to finish what remained to be done.

Granted to the Rev. Mr Israel Loring including his Salary & Firewood, in full for the Year ensuing } 65 0 0

Granted to the Rev. Mr Wm Cook including his Salary and Firewood, in full, for the Year ensuing } 65 0 0

The Town Voted to Provide a Grammar School Master, for the Year ensuing, & Granted for the support of the Grammar School 20 0 0

Voted by Sd Town that the Grammar School should be kept in four Places Viz: at the School Houses near the two Meeting Houses, & that school House near Mr Joseph Smiths and at the School House near Mr Nathan Goodenows.

Voted by Sd Town the Selectmen of Sd Town, should serve as a Committee to Provide a Grammar Schoolmaster

Granted for the support of the Reading & Writing Schools, in Sd Town the Year ensuing 14 0 0

and Ordered that the School should be kept at four places Viz: at the School House near Mr Samuel Puffers and at the School House near Deacon Rices & near to the House of Joseph Stanhopes & at, or, near the House, of Dea James Brewers.

The Town by a Vote, Accepted, of the Settlement, made between the Selectmen, & the Town Treasurer, Mr Saml Parris

The Town Appointed Aaron Johnson to take care off & Sweep the West meeting House, the Year ensuing & to dig Graves as there may be occasion.

The Town Appointed John Ross to take care off & Sweep the East meeting House the Year ensuing, & to dig graves as there may be occasion.

Granted for to repair the High ways in the Town of 40 0 0

and Voted that every Person upon due Notice should have Liberty to work out their proportion of this Tax

Granted for the Relief of the Poor in Sd Town, the Year ensuing the Sum of 10 0 0

Granted for to finish, the Repairing of the Meeting Houses 9 0 0

And then the Town by a Vote Ordered that the several Sums aforesaid by them Granted, for the several purposes aforesaid, should be by their Appearances, Apes., on the Inhabitants of Sd Town, with all convenient speed and the Work of the Sd Meeting, being finished, the meeting was dissolved.
