the Town being met at time & place, proceeded & chose for their
Representative for the ensuing Year, Maj^r John Noyes, being a
Freeholder & resident in Said Town.

At Said Meeting May 17th 1757 The Town proceeded & chose Ebenezer
Roby Esq^r Moderator.

Voted by Said Town, that the swine in Said Town go at large the
Year ensuing

The third Article relating, to the discontinuing a High Way, &
put to Vote, & the Town by their Vote discontinued the Way, during
their pleasure, on condition of Cap^t Damons making Good Gate
or Bars.

It was put to Vote, whether the Town would grant a Sum of money
for to repair the High Way the present Year, and it pass'd in the
Negative; and the Town by their Vote transfer'd the last Years Rates
into the present Collectors Hand, & impow'ed them to Collect Said
Rates.

At a Selectmen's Meeting in Sudbury July 18th 1757
Then agreed with Mr Wm Cook Jun^r to keep the Grammar School
in Said Town, for the Space of two months, and to begin on
Monday next, at the School House, by the East Meeting House
in Said Town; After the rate of Twenty Six Pounds Thir-
teen Shillings & four pence pr Year & four Shillings pr Week for Board

We the Subscribers the Fence Viewers for Sudbury, being complained
unto by Reynolds Seager of Sudbury, in Sd County, Merchant, that Leason
How of Sd Sudbury, Yeoman, had enclosed a Close, in Sd Sudbury, which
Close, Joyned, to the Said Reynolds Close, wherein his Barn now stands.
And that the Partition Fence between him, & the Sd Levitt, was his for
the Length of Seventy Six Rods, and that the Sd Levitt How, had
and did, neglect, and refuse to divide, the Fence between them, or pay
and Satisfie the Sd Reynolds, for one half of his Fence which by Law
He is Obliged to do.

And we the Subscribers gave the Said Levitt, due Notice of the Sd Rey-
nolds complaint, and warned him, the Sd Levitt, to attend on the divi-
sion and Apprizement this Day, who appeared & consented to our proceed-
ing in the Sd Affair, and after we, in the presence, & by the consent
of both the Sd Parties, Had measured the Sd Fence, we sett off to the
Sd Reynolds Seager, forty Eight Rod, & a half & one Link, And we began
at the Country Road, and Run for the said by the Number of Rods & Link
in the said & heap of Stones, And from thence we Run the same Number of the
