

- 10th To see if the Town will Sell to Amos Smith, a Small piece of Land, in the Thirty Rod High Way, lying within his fence, as may appear by a Plan of Said Land.
- 11th To see what the Town will do, with respect to Dido, a Negro Woman who is now upon Charge, in this Town.
- 12th To See if the Town will Acquit their right, to such part of the thirty Rod High Ways, as is not yet sold, To the Inhabitants of the New Grants, in Sudbury, on such Terms as may be agreed on, Agreeable to a Petition of Daniel Woodward & Others.
- 13th To see if the Town will Accept the Plan, of two Acres & Sixty two Rod of Land, Sold to Joseph Noyes, by the Towns Committee, in the thirty Rod High Way & Order it to be Recorded.
- 14th To See if the Town will Grant Money, to pay their Assessors & Town Treasurer, this Present Year.
- And make return of this Order, with your doings herein, to the Town Clerk, at least one Day, before the aforesaid Meeting.
