The Town Voted to provide a Grammar School Master for the ensuing Year & Granted for the support of same 30 0 0
And Ordered that it should be kept at the School House near the Meeting Houses & at that School House Near Mr Joseph Smith & at the School House Near Mr Nathan Goodenows.
Granted for the Support of the Reading & Writing Schools in the Town the Year ensuing 14 0 0
And Ordered that the Sd School should be kept in four places viz: at the School House Near Mr Saml Suffer & at the School House Near Deacon Rice, and Near to the House of Joseph Stanhopes & at or Near the House of Dea: James Brewsters
The Town Appointed Aaron Johnson to take care off & sweep the West Meeting House the Year ensuing & to dig Graves as there may be Occasion
The Town Appointed John Ross to take care off & sweep the East Meeting House the Year ensuing & to dig Graves as there may be Occasion
Granted for the Relief of the Poor in Sd Town the Year ensuing the Sum of 20
Then the Town by their Vote Adjourned their Meeting to Tuesday the first day of November Next, to meet at the East Meeting House, in Sudbury at twelve o Clock at Noon

The Town being met at time & place Auording, to the Aforesaid Adjournment, they proceeded to finish what remained
The Seventh Article relating to Capt Segers Petition & Others, the first Cause Contained in Sd Petition was put to Vote & the Town Voted that they would take an Effectual Method, to prevent Cutting Wood and Timber & removing Bound Marks on the thirty Rod High Way so Called in Sd Town - - - - - the Second Cause Contained in the above Petition, was put to Vote & pass'd in the Affirmative, and the Town impowere their Standing Committee to prosecute the above Article so far as they shall think necessary.
The 8th Article was put to Vote & pass'd in the Negative
The Town by their Vote, Granted the sum of ten pounds to enable the Committee to proceed in the Affair of the thirty Rod High Way & Order that it should be payd out of the Bonds, that are in the Town Treasurers Hand.
The Town by a Vote Granted to Amos Smith to him, his Heirs, & Assigns a small piece of Land, in the Westerly thirty Rod High Way so Call'd in the New Grant Land, Joyning to his Original Grant Lott, Bounded Easterly by his New Standing fence, & every way else by his own Land or & in Consideration of six Shillings Lawful Money
The Town by their Vote Ordered the Select Men of Sudbury, to make strict enquiry who brought Dido into Town.
