- To Wm Parmenter about five Acres in the West 30 Rod Way at twenty six Shillings ^{per Acre}.
- To Paltiah Parmenter in the West 30 Rod Way about three Acres at eight Shilling ^{per Acre} -- Also agreed that shall be land left for a Way on the Southerly Side. next to Joseph Stanhopes Land
- To Joseph Stanhope about two Acres & half near his House. in the West 30 Rod Way at one pound ^{per Acre}
- To Oliver Morse in the West 30 Rod Way about 12 Acres Northerly of his Fathers House at four Shillings ^{per Acre}
- To John Walker about 14 Acres in the West 30 Rod Way, Near his House at four Shillings ^{per Acre}
- To Joseph Willis about two Acres in the East 30 Rod Way Northerly of Mr. Peter Rogers Meadow at forty Shillings ^{per Acre} -- Also about two Acres East of Putnam's Joyning to his own Land at four Shillings ^{per Acre} -- Also about one Acre between Putnam's & the Meadow at eight Shillings ^{per Acre} -- Also about one Acre of Meadows at two pounds & six Shillings & eight pence ^{per Acre} -- Also to Joseph Willis about three Acres of upland Joyning on the South Side. of the Meadow at one pound six Shillings ^{per Acre}.
- To Obadiah Perry & Joseph Willis about 30 Acres between T. D. Perry's Land and Pond called Willis's Pond at five Shillings ^{per Acre}
- To Deacon Jonathan Rice in the West 30 Rod Way, in the New Grant about six Acres at seven Shillings & six pence ^{per Acre} -- Also about two Acres in the Same Way Joyning on the North Side of Hows Road at seven Shillings & six pence ^{per Acre} -- Also to Deac. Jonathan Rice about 18 Acres in the Same Way, on the South Side of Hows Road to Willis's Pond at seven Shillings & six pence ^{per Acre}
- 4th To See if the Town will give leave to Mr. Lebadiah Allen & Maj. Joseph Curtis to hang convenient Gales & Sett Trees Across the Road leading by the three Ponds (so called) to Mr. John Parmenters, Agreeable to a Petition of T. D. Allen & others.
- 5th To See if the Town will allow, out of the Interest Money, Arising by the Bonds, in the Town Treasurers Hands, To Entrain Curtis & Jonathan Smith two Dollars, which they paid, to Capt John Haines for four Days Attendance in shewing the Bounds of the thirty Rod High Way to Sam. Livermore Esq. When he was Ordered to take a Plan by the Superior Court
- 6th To See if the Town will give to the Heirs of Mr. John Green Deacon the thirty Rod High Way Running East & West through the Green's Grant except the four Rods for the Town Road.
