

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned May 17th 1758 The Town being met at time & Place, Proceeded & chose for their Representative the ensuing Year Col. John Noyes, being a Freeholder & Resident in said Town.

At Said Meeting May 17th 1758 the Town proceeded & chose Col. John Noyes Moderator.

1st Voted by S^d Town, that the Swine may go at large the Year ensuing.

2^d The Town by their Vote, Voted to defend the Tithes the Towns Committee viz: Ephraim Curtis Esq^r Capt Tho^s Damon & Mr Jonathan Smith, should give to the Persons hereafter Named.

Also the Town, gave leave the following Plans may be Recorded the purchasers paying the Cost of Recording them.

The Town Accepted of Mr Oliver Moses Plan of Nineteen Acres and Sixty Rods & gave leave, it may be Recorded.

The Town by their Vote Accepted of Mr Samuel Knights Plan of Six Acres & half & twenty Rods, & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town by their Vote Accepted of Capt. Reynolds Segers Plan of twenty Acres & gave leave it may be Recorded. Also the Town Accepted of Daniel Goodenows & Asher Cutler's Bond as pay for Capt Segers Land: as Above.

The Town by their Vote Accepted of Ebenezer Roby's Esq^r Plan of twenty Acres & an 140 Rods. Also Accepted of Another Plan of fourteen Acres & half Acre & gave leave they may be Recorded.

The Town by their Vote Accepted of Mr Ezekiel How's Plan of one Acre & 77 Rods & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town by their Vote Accepted of Mr Ezekiel Parmenters & Jedidiah Parmenters Plan of Seven Acres & 127 Rods, & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town by their Vote Accepted of Mr W^m Parmenters Plan of three Acres & 38 Rods & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town Accepted of Mr Salthah Parmenters Plan of three Acres & 44 Rods. Also Agreed there should be land left for a High Way Next to Joseph Stanhopes Land of two Rods Wide & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town Accepted of Mr Joseph Stanhopes Plan of two Acres & 144 Rods & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town Accepted of Mr Joseph Willis's Plans of three Acres & 133 Rods. Also Seven Acres & 126 Rods. Also one Acre & 82 Rods & gave leave they may be Recorded.

The Town Accepted of Mr Joseph Willis's & Obadiah Perrys Plan of eighteen Acres & 27 Rods & gave leave it may be Recorded.

The Town Accepted of Obadiah Perrys Plan of ten Acres & 69 Rods & gave leave it may be Recorded.

4th The Town by their Vote gave leave to Lebadiah Allen & Joseph Curtis to Set fences & hang Gates Across the Road leading by the three Ponds (so Called) to John Parmenters, Agreeable to their Petition. during the Towns Pleasure.

5th The Town by their Vote granted to Ephraim Curtis Esq^r & Mr Jonathan Smith, two Dollars which they paid to Capt John Noyes for four Days Service in Shewing Bounds.
