

7th The Town by their Vote chose Maj^r Joseph Curtis to act as Agent for S. D. Town at the Next Sessions, to answer to a Report of a Committee in laying out a Road from Concord to Marlborond and granted the Sum of fifty Shillings to enable him to carry on S. D. Affairs S. D. money to be taken out of the Unappropriated money in the Town Treasurers hands

8th The Town by their Vote gave leave to Capt^r Moses Brewer to build a pul over the Womens Stairs, in such a manner as not to incommode any Person - on his paying the Town of Sudbury two pounds thirteen Shillings & 4^d Lawfull money

9th Article passed in the Negative

10th The Town by their Vote; Voted to repair their High Ways by a Rate the present Year & granted the Sum of Sixty pounds for repairing the same & empowered the Surveyors to be Collectors of S. D. Rate And Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate forthwith

Then the Town by their Vote adjourned the Meeting to Monday the twelfth Day of March Inst. to meet at the House of Mr Isaac Baldwin Inholder in S. D. Town at 3 o Clock Afternoon

The Town being met at time & place according to the aforesd adjournment proceeded to finish what remained to be done
