

- 2^d To see if the Town will give liberty, that the Swine may go at large in T. Town, the Year Ending
- 3^d To see if the Town will accept of M^r Daniel Bowshers plan of Land, Sold him in the New Grant, thirty Rod High Way, And Order it to be Recorded
- 4th To see if the Town will give leave to M^r Eliakim Rice and M^r Jonathan Underwood to Build a pue over the Mens Stairs in the East Meeting House in T. Town, so as not to incommode any Person, and to Build it at their own Cost - on such Terms as the Town and they shall Agree too when met
- 5th To See if the Town will Grant & Confirm to M^r Daniel Woodward his Heirs & Assigns - All the thirty Rod wide High Way Joyning to his Land, within his terme for such a Sum of money as the Town & D. Woodward shall agree too when met

And make Return of this Order with your doings therein to the Town Clerk, at least one Day before the aforesaid Meeting -

In Obedience to the within written Order I have Warned the Freeholders and other Inhabitants off & Belonging to Sudbury in my Ward, Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town Affairs And in the choice of Representatives to meet at time & place within mentioned

Sudbury May 13th 1759

The Return of the other three Constables orders were as the Law Directs & were Accepted by T. Town

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury legally Warned May 15th 1759 the Town being met at time & place provided & chose for their Representative the ensuing Year Col. John Noyes - a Freeholder & Resident in T. Town

At T. Meeting May 15th 1759 The Town Proceeded & chose Col. John Noyes Moderator

2^d The Town by their Vote gave liberty for the Swine to go at large, in T. Town the Year Ending

4th The Town by their Vote gave liberty to M^r Eliakim Rice & M^r Jonathan Underwood to Build a pue over the Mens Stairs in the East Meeting House - T. Rice & Underwood to Build it at their Cost & charge & to Build it in such a manner as not to incommode any Person
