These Order you to warn, All the Freeholders & other Inhabitants off and belonging to Sudbury, in your Ward, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs to Meet at the East Meeting House in Sudbury, on Tuesday the twenty third Day of October Inst: at twelve o'clock at Noon — then & there —
- 1st To Bring in Town Debt & Credit.
 - 2^d To see if the Town will Grant, their Rev. Ministers an Honourable Gratuity for the Year ensuing, including their Salary and Firewood.
 - 3^d To See if the Town will Provide a Grammar school Master & Order where the School shall be kept the Ensuing Year & Grant money for the Support of the Same.
 - 4th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Support of the Reading & Writing Schools, And Order where sd Schools shall be kept the ensuing Year.
 - 5th To See if the Town will Appoint a Man or Men to take Care off — and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses in sd Town the Year ensuing — And dig Graves as there may be occasion.
 - 6th To See if the Town will Grant Money, for the Relief of the Poor in sd Town, the Year ensuing.
 - 7th To See if the Town will grant Money to pay their Assessors the Present Year.
 - 8th To See if the Town will Grant Money, to Repair their Meeting Houses.
 - 9th To See if the Town will Grant & confirm to Daniel Bouker a piece of Land, sold him by the Towns Committee, in the Upper 30 Rods wide High Way — Agreeable to his plan of sd Land — And Order it to be Recorded.
 - 10th To See if the Town will Grant & confirm to John Brigham three Acres & thirteen Rods of Land sold him by the Towns Committee in the Easterly thirty Rods wide High Way And Order it to be Recorded.
 - 11th To See if Town will Grant & confirm to Simeon Harris about half an Acre of Land, sold him by the Towns Committee in the West 30 Rods wide high Way, — Agreeable to his Plan of said Land and
