

- 6th To See if the Town will discontinue the Way Leading from Mr Sam^l Stanhopes, to the Great River Meadows till it comes to Mr Shincas Haynes Lott - And Acept of the Way laid out by the Select Men from D Haynes Lott into the Way Leading by D Stanhopes to the New Bridge - And Order the Same to be Recorded - - - - -
 - 7th To See if the Town will give leave for Mr Aaron Johnson & Mr Daniel Bowker to Build a pue in the West Meeting House over the Womens Stairs & to cut a Window for the Conveniency of the Same, Sd pue to be built at their Cost and in Such a manner as not to discommode any Person
 - 8th To see if the Town will give leave for James Puffer Sam^l Dahin Leabel Wheler Wm Rice Jun^r & Luke Moore to Build a pue over the Mens Stairs And to cut a Window for the conveniency of the Same - Sd pue to be Built at their Cost and in Such a manner as not to discommode any Person
 - 9th To See if the Town will choose a Committee to agree with the Persons who have Damages Allowed them by the Courts Comm^{tee} in laying out a County Road through their Land from Concord to Marlboro - Or Act any other way in Sd Affair As the Town shall think proper when met - - - - -
 - 10th To See if the Town will asept of a Way laid out by the Select Men of Sudbury - Leading from the County Road by Mr Tho^s Carr^s, Across Land now in possession of Benj^a Wrights Heirs, till it comes to Lancaster Road, Sd Way laid out at the Request of Mr Tho^s Carr - - - - -
 - 11th To See if the Town will grant & confirm to Prehel How his Heirs and Assigns for ever, about twenty four Acres of Land lying in the West 30 Rods Wide High Way, for Such a Sum of money as the Town & Sd How shall agree too when met, And Order the Plan of Sd Land to be Recorded - - - - -
 - 12th To See if the Town will Grant & Confirm to Matthias Rice about three Quarters of an Acre of Land, lying in the West 30 Rods wide High Way for such a Sum of Money as the Town And Sd Rice shall agree to o when met And Order the Same to be Recorded - - - - -
 - 13th To See if the Town will allow to the Persons, who are in the Service of the Government at Nova Scotia (and have been for the Winter detained in Sd Service) their Province Tax
 - 14th To See if the Town will Asept of the List of Jurors, as they are put into the Select Men - - - - -
 - 15th To See if the Town will Grant & Confirm to Simeon Harris his Heirs & Assigns for ever about 70 Rods of Land lying in the West 30 Rods Wide High Way, Sold him by the Towns Comm^{tee} Agreeable to his plan of Sd Land & Order the Same to be Recorded - - - - -
