The Return of the other three Orders were as the Law direct & were Accepted by the Town

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury Legally Warned March 3^d 1760 the Town being met at time & place proceeded & chose Col. John Noyes Moderator - then the Town proceeded to the Work of the Day And chose their Town Officers, as follows viz!
