These Order you to Warn all the Freeholders & other Inhabitants off
and belonging to Sudbury, in 4th Ward, Qualified as the Law Directs to
Vote in Town Affairs and in the choise of Representatives, to meet
at the East Meeting House in Sudbury on Wednesday the fourteenth of
this Moth May at two o'Clock After-noon.

1st To Elect & depute one or more Person or Persons being Freeholders and
And Resident in T^h Town; to Serve for & Represent T^h Town at a great
and General Court or Assembly, Appointed to be convened, held & kept
for his Majesties Service at the Court House in Boston on Wednesday the
twenty eighth Day of May Cur^t at Nine o'Clock A.M. And so de
die in Diem during their Session or Sessions, As Directed in the
Precept Sent to T^h Town.

2^d To See if the Town will give liberty, that the Swine may go at
large in T^h Town - the Year ensuing.

3^d To See if the Town will hear the Report of their Committee that were
chose last March, to agree with those Persons that had Damages
Allowed them, by the Court Committee, in laying out a Way thro
their Lands, Leading from Concord to Marlboro And do and Act on T^h
Report, As the Town shall think proper when met.

4th To See if the Town will Grant a Sum of money for the Relief of
the Poor in T^h Town, or Appropriate to that Use, Some partt of the
money which was taken for Lands, Sold in the New Grants.

5th To See if the Town will Accept of the List of Jurors and Select out
one Quarter of T^h List - to Serve as Jurors at the Superior Court -
Agreeable to a late Act of the General Assembly.

6th To See if the Town will discontinue the Way lying between the Lands
of M^r Joseph Maynard & the land formerly M^r Tho^s Brigham's And
dispose of it As the Town shall think proper when met.

7th To See if the Town by their Vote will Order the two Precinct Books
to be delivered, to the Town Clerk - to be kept with the other Town
Books in T^h Town.

And make due Return of this Order with your doings therein to the Town
Clerk at least one Day before the aforesaid Meeting.
