School
- 4th To See if the Town will grant money for the Support
of the Reading and Writing School, and Order where the
Schools shall be kept the Ensuing year
- 5th To See if the Town will Appoint a Man or Men to take
Care off and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses in T. Town
the Year ensuing and Graves as there may be Occasion
- 6th To See if the Town will grant money for the Relief of the
Poor in T. Town the Year ensuing
- 7th To See if the Town will grant money to pay their Up-
siders the present year . . .
- 8th To See if the Town will Accept of the Settlement made
with the Town Treasurer M^r Sam^l Farris, (by the Select Men)
And Order the same to be Recorded . . .
- 9th To See if the Town will discontinue the Town Way lead-
ing by M^r Edward Adams, Dwelling House to M^r Josiah
Farrars, or any part of T. Way. Also Choose a Committee
to dispose of the same
- 10th To See if the Town will grant thirty three pounds Six
Shillings & 8^d to pay M^r Stephen Farrar M^r Eliab Stone
M^r Crocker & M^r Thayer for supplying M^r Cooks Pulpit
in his Confinement - Also Grant a further Sum of Money
to Supply either of the Pulpits in T. Town, As Ocasion may
be. Also Choose a Committee to Supply M^r Cooks Pulpit
during his sickness.
- 11th To See if the Town will Order, that the Several School
Houses in T. Town shall be Repaired & Grant a Sum of
money to Repair the same
- 12th To See if the Town ^{would Grant} and confirm to Lieut^t Augustus Moore his
Heirs & Assigns for ever about forty Acres of Land in the
New Grant 30 Rod Wide High Way (so called) sold to him by
the Towns Committee (viz^t) Cap^t Tho^s Damon & M^r Jonathan Smith
