

- 8th The Town by their Vote Accepted the Settlement made by the Select Men, with Mr Sam^l Parris Town Treasurer - Also Ordered the same to be Recorded
- 9th The Town by their Vote discontinued the Town way leading by Mr Edward Adams, beginning at the Corner of S. D Adams' Field (on the South Side of S. D Way) till it comes to Lincoln line; excepting a Way that crosses S. D Way, leading from Josiah Tarram to Daniel Parks, which was lately laid out - Also by their Vote Chose M^r Ezra Graves Maj^r Joseph Curtis & Lieut Elisha Wheeler as a Comm^{tee} to dispose of the same
- 10th The Town by their Vote Granted thirty three pounds Six Shillings and 8^d to pay Mr Stephen Tarrar M^r Eliab Stone Mr Crocker and Mr ~~Tarrar~~ Thayer for supplying Mr Cooks Pulpit in his confinement Also Granted thirty pounds to supply Mr Cooks Pulpit in his sickness Furthermore the Town by their Vote chose a Comm^{tee} viz^t M^r Samuel Parris Maj^r Jo^s Curtis & W^m Baldwin to provide Preaching during M^r Cooks confinement
- 11th The Town by their Vote, Voted to Repair the Several School Houses in S. D Town at the Towns Cost and granted twenty pounds for the Repairing the same
- 12th The Town by their Vote granted and confirmed to Lieut Augustus Moore his Heirs & Assigns forever about forty Acres of Land in the New Grants 30 Rod wide high Way so called sold him by the Towns Comm^{tee} and Ordered his plans of S. D Land to be Recorded.
- 13th This Article was put to Vote & passed in the Negative

At a Meeting of the Select Men of Sudbury Octob^r: 28th 1760 at S. D Meeting we Settled Accounts with Mr Samuel Parris Treasurer for the Town of Sudbury and we find the several Ballances in his hands due to the Town viz^t out of the Money granted for the Support of the Grammar school in the Year 1759 twelve pounds fourteen Shillings and four for the Reading & Writing School five pounds five Shillings & 8^d for the Repairing of the Meeting Houses twenty five pounds three Shillings and 4^d
