Noon on S. d Day. then and there to Act as followeth vizt:

- 1st To bring in Town Debts and Credit
- 2^d To See if the Town will provide a Grammar School Master and
Order where the School shall be kept the ensuing Year & Grant
money for the Support of the Same
- 3^d To See if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of the Reading
and Writing Schools - and ^{of them} where the Schools shall be kept the
ensuing Year
- 4th To See if the Town will appoint a Man or Men to take Care off
and Sweep each of the Meeting Houses in T. d Town the Year ensuing
And to digg Graves as there may be Ocasion
- 5th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of the Poor
in T. d Town the Year ensuing
- 6th To See if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessors the
present Year
- 7th To See if the Town will Accept the Settlement the Select Men
have made with the Town Treasurer, Mr Samuel Parris and Order
the Same to be Recorded
- 8th To See if the Town will Grant a further sum of Money to Re-
pair the Meeting Houses, in T. d Town and Order How d Money
shall be disposed off
- 9th To See if the Town will dispose off or mend the old Town Bell
or Grant a Sum of money to purchase two New ones - Also
Grant a Sum of money to Build some Suitable places, at or Near
each of the Meeting Houses, in T. d Town; to Hang T. d Bells on
Or do and Act any other way in T. d Affair, as the Town shall
think proper when met - Agreeable to a Petition of Benjamin
Estabrooks and others
- 10th To see if the Town by their Vote will take the Tickets in Sudbury
Lottery fourth Cps. that shall Remain in the Managers Hand
unsold, when the drawing of the T. d Lottery shall commence
- 11th To See if the Town will discontinue, such a part of the Town W.
(Leading by Mr James Haynes to Daniel Bowkers) as they shall
think proper, ~~where~~ and choose a Comm^{tee} to dispose of the Same
