the Work that Remained to be done -

13th Article pass'd in the Negative -

14th The Town by their Vote Granted to the Rev. Mr Israel Loring Seventy
four pounds including his Salary and Firewood - 74 0 0

15th The Town by their Vote Granted to Mr Josiah Bridge his Settlement
and Salary as he had contracted with the East Society for and Order
the Apepos to Apeps the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury
for the Same - - - 274 - -

16th The Town by their Vote Ordered the Town Treasurer Mr Samuel
Parris forthwith to Call in the money due on the Bonds for Lands
Sold in the New Grants 30 Rods Wide High Way
