2^d To See if the Town by their Vote, will give liberty for Horses
to go at large (without Fetters) any part of the time from the
first of April to the last of November the Year ensuing
3^d To See if the Town, will Repair their High Ways, by a Rate the
present Year, and grant a Suitable sum of money for Repairing the
the Same - and Impower the Surveyors to be collectors of said
Rate - Also Order the Asepors to make it into a Rate forthwith -
4th To See if the Town by their Vote will give liberty, for the Sheep to
go at large, in sd Town, any part of the time, from the fifteenth Day
of March Next to the first Day of May Next. - - -
5th To See if the Town will Order the Town Treasurer to pay Mr Phineas
Brintnall (out of the unappropriated money in his hands) for his
Service in Collecting the Rates in the North Ward on the East Side
of the River in Sudbury, As Agreed with by the Select-Men -
6th To See if the Town will discontinue, that part of the Town Way
Leading to Daniel Deans old House spot - Beginning at the Bounds
of Eli Noyes, Land, to Weston Bounds, Near where Daniel Deans
old House stood, and Sell the same to J. Noyes, As the Select-Men
and he shall agree - - - - -
7th To See if the Town will Acept of Abijah Brigham's Plan of a piece of
High Way, which he bought of the Town, Lying Southerly of Joseph
Maynards and Grant and Confirm the Same to J. Brigham and
Order it to be Recorded. - - - - -
8th To See if the Town will hire some Suitable House for a Work House
that the Idle Persons in sd Town might be kept to Labour -
9th To See if the Town will Acept the Report of the Select-Men in the Sale
of the Road Leading by Mr James Haynes, and Order the Same to be
Recorded - - - And make ^{due} Return of this Order with your
doings thereon to the Select-Men at time & place above mentioned
