

- 13th To See if the Town will Accept of the way laid out by the Select-men for the benefit of Mr. Asher Cutler's way beginning at a Swamp Oak standing in Joseph Read land and thence running Easterly by the fence on the North Side and Marked Trees on the South Side of the way till it comes one Rod East of P. Cutler's Meadow Bars the land for P. way was left by the Proprietors for a way — — — — —
- 14th To See if the Town will Grant to Uriah Gibbs and others the hind and part of the Nest in the mens Front Gallery in the West Meetinghouse Agreeable to their petition — — — — —
- 15th To See if the Town will Accept of the Road leading from the Corner of Shemuel Griffins Field East of D. Griffins House leading from thence to Westown Bound as it is laid out by the Select-men — — — — —
- 16th To See if the Town will Grant a Sum of Money to finish repairing the Meeting Houses — — — — —
- 17th To See if the Town will Vote and Order that the Money that the Money Granted for the Support of the Grammar School in D. Town shall be for the Future be Equally Divided Between the West Side and the East in proportion to their pay Agreeable to a Petition of Josiah Richardson and others — — — — —
- 18th To See if the Town will Dismiss the Select-men from being a Committee to Dispose of the Old Town Bell and Chuse a New Committee And fully Impower them to Dispose of D. Bell — — — — —
- 19th To See if the Town will Consent to the Alteration the Select-men have made in the County Road Near Mr. Tho^s Carrs House and Except of the Other as it is laid out by the Select-men — — — — —
- 20th To See if the Town by their Vote will Choose an Agent or Agents or a Committee and fully Impower them to Examine into the Affair of the Two Cowpen Lots and Report what is proper to be Done at their Next Town Meeting or as soon as may be Agreeable to a Petition of Sam^l Ruple and others — — — — —
