

- 3^d The Town by their Vote Appropriated The Sum of Twenty Pound of the Unappropriated money in the Town Treasurer hand for repairing the meeting houses in said Town Deducting twelve pound five Shillings and four pence which is already expended in repairing the meeting Houses in sd Town
 - 4th The Town by their Vote Appropriated the Sum of Twenty Pound out of the unappropriated money in the Town Treasurer hand for the Relief of the poore in sd Town and Ordered the Town Treasurer to pay out the same by Order of the sd Overseers
 - 5th The Rules Orders and by Laws that the Overseers of the poore in said Town had made for the Regulation of the workhouse in sd Town was Read and put to vote and The Town by their Vote Established and Confirmed the same
 - 6th The Town ^{voted} to Chuse a Constable in the Room of m^r. Tho^s Bent upon his Refusing to serve and accordingly chose m^r. Micah Maynard Constable
 - 7th The Town by their vote Excepted of East Israel Moore's plan of one Acre and fifty Rod of Land in the 30 Rod Highway so called for the Sum of Four Shillings and Ordered the same to be Recorded
