

- 5th To See if the Town will appoint a Man or men to take care off and sweep each of the Meeting Houses in D Town the year Ensuing and to digg Graves as there may be Ocasion
 - 6th To See if the Town will Grant Money for the Relief of the Poore in D Town the present year
 - 7th To See if the Town will Grant and Confirm to m^r Abadiah Perry a Tract of land in the Middle Thirty Rod wide Highway agreeable to his plan of D land and Order the same to be recorded
 - 8th To See if the Town will rebuild or repair that Bridge across the River Near m^r Edward Shermans and Grant a sum of money for the same or do or act any other way as the Town shall think proper when meet
 - 9th To See if the Town will hear and Except of the report of the Towns Com^{to} viz Esq^r Roby and others
 - 10th To See if the Town will Grant and Confirm to Esq^r Jabez Puffer and Capt. Elijah Smith part of the two hind seats on the floare in the west Meeting House to Build a pew for each of them at such a Price as the Town and they shall agree upon at D Meeting
 - 11th To See if the Town will Grant money to pay their Lifesort and Town Treasurer the present year
- And Make Due Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the Town Clerk at least One Day before the afore^d Meeting.
