

- 6th To see if the Town will Discontinue the Highway from Flow line to the House that was formerly ^{Col} Richard Taylors Agreeable to a Petition of m^r Jonathan Smith and others and Dispose of the same
- 7th To see if the Town will Excuse Timothy Emms from the Highway Rate the present year Agreeable to his Petition
- 8 To see if the Town will Order the Select Men to appear att Charlestown Court to Oppose the County Road from Frammingham Meeting House by ^{Col} Noah Eatons through the west part of Sudbury to Concord that sd Eaton has Petitioned for
- 9th To see if the Town will accept of a Highway as Laid out by the Selectmen from the widows Eonies Grant of sd Town to Winstown line and Order the same to be Recorded
- 10th To see if the Town will accept of a Highway laid out by the Select Men in sd Town through John Fraizers field to the head of the Great Meadow and Discontinue the Old Road from sd Fraizers House to the Great Meadow and Give to him in Liew of the New Road
- 11th To see if the Town will appropriate a sum of Money out of the New Grant Bond to Purchase or hire a work=
= House and Provide Materials proper for the same or Do or Act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 12th To see if the Town will accept of the List of Jurious as Put into the Box by the Select Men
- 13th To see if the Town will accept of the Settlement that the Select Men have made with the Town Treasurer and Order the same to be Recorded

And Make Due Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the Town Clerk at least two Days before the aforesd meeting
