year Ensuing and to Dig Graves as there may be occasion
- 6th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Relief
of the Poore in sd Town the Present year —
- 7th To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessor
and Town Treasurers the present year —
- 8th To see if the Town will Accept of Capt. Seagers New Plan of Twenty
Acres of Land in the 30 Rod highway in the Room of a Plan the
sd Town formerly gave the sd Seager to the sd Seager and Leo^t Hopstill
Brown Consenting to the Bound as set forth in sd plan agreeable
to the petition of sd Seager and Order the same to be Recorded
- 9th To see if the Town will Grant to Capt. Ezekiel How Two Pound Ten
Shillings out of the New Grant money it being their proportion of
Twenty Pounds Granted for repairing the School Houses in sd Town
- 10th To see if the Town will Grant such a sum of money to Repair
the School Houses in sd Town as the Town shall think proper
when met
