These Order you to warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants off and belonging in your ward Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town Affairs and in the Choice of Representation to meet at the west Meeting House in D Town on Monday the Thirtieth Day of May Next at One O'Clock afternoone on D Day Then and there

1st To Elect and Depute one or more Person or Persons being Freeholders and Resident in D Town to Serve for and Represent D Town at a Great and General Court or Assembly Appointed to be Held Convened Held and Kept for his Majesties Service at the Town House in Boston on Wednesday the Twentieth Day of May Next at Nine O'Clock forenoone and so to Continue in Diem During their Session or Sessions as Directed in the Precept Sent to D Town

2^d To See if the Town will Choose a Committee to Build a Stone Pound and Order where D Pound shall be Built or Do or Act as the Town shall think proper when meet
