In Observance of the within Order I have warned and caused to be warned the Freeholders and other Inhabitants in my ward qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town Affairs to meet at time and place within mentioned
Sudbury May 8th A.D. 1768 Aaron Haynes } Constable

The Returns of the other two Constables was as the Law Directs and was accepted by the Town.

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury legally warned May 13th 1768

The Town being met at time and place proceeded and chose
1st Col^l. John Noyes for their Representative the year ensuing a Freeholder and Resident in S. Town

At a meeting the Town proceeded and chose Col^l. John Noyes Moderator

2^d Voted to Build a New Stone Pound between Lot Augustus Moore Dwelling House and the Gravel pit on Col^l. Noyes Land which he promised to give to the Town to sett a Pound on by Deed The Town by their vote agreed with Col^l. Jonathan Parmenter to Build a new sufficient Stone Pound at S. place 30 feet square from inside to inside six feet high with Pieces of timber Lock together Round the Top 8 inches square for six Pound? and the Old Pound to the Exceptance of the Select Men or Comtee Likewise to keep the Old Pound in Repair till he had built S. New Pound
