- 1st To bring in Town Debt and Credit
- 2^d To see if the Town will provide a Grammar
School Master and Order where the School shall be
kept the Ensuing year and grant money for the support
of the same
- 3^d To see if the Town will Grant their Rev^d Minister
their salary the year Ensuing
- 4th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the support
of the Reading and writing school and Order where the
School shall be kept the Ensuing year
- 5th To see if the Town will appoint a man or men to take
care off and sweep each of the Meetinghouses in sd Town
the year Ensuing and Dig Graves as there may be Occasion
- 6th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the relief of
the poore in sd Town the present year
- 7th To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their
Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year
- 8th To see if the Town will Grant or appropriate Two Pounds
Ten shillings out of the New Grant Bond in the Town
Treasure, hand toward rebuilding the schoolhouse near
the East Meetinghouse in sd Town
- 9th To see if the Town when met will Give Instructions
to their Representative in this Petical season
