Art. 9 The Town by their vote proceeded to act on the ninth Article and it was put to vote to see if the Town would Give their present Representative Instructions and it past in the Affirmative and the Town by their vote Choose a Comtee of three men viz Mr. Will^m Rice Mr. Thomas Noynton & John Maynard to Draw up the Instructions and bring them to the Town for their Exceptance

Then the Town by their vote Adjourned their Meeting till Monday Next at twelve O^l Clock Noone at this place

Monday Oct. 21. 1765 the Town being meet at time and place according to the fore^{sd} Adjournment Proceeded as followeth
