At a Town meeting in Sudbury Legally warned May 13th 1767 —
The Town Being met at Time & place provided & Chose for their Represen-
tative the Ensuing year John Royce Esq^r a freeholder & Resident in
said Town —

2^d The Town by their vote appropriated Twenty six pounds Thirteen shillings
& four pence out of the New Grant Security to supply the work House &
pay the Charge of Wm Dunm^r Cause —

3^d The Town by their vote Ordered the Collectors to allow the persons
that worked at the Highways 3^d p^r Day for a man & 1^d 6 for a yoke
of Oxen & 1^d 6 p^r Day for a Cart till the first Day of Sept^r Next —

4th The Town by their vote Voted to have a Nother Trial in Wm
Dunm^r Cause —

5th The Town by their vote Excepted of the Selectmens Settlement
with their Treasurer M^r Tho: Plympton —

Then the Town By their vote Dissolved their meeting

at one o'Clock in the after Noon on said Day —

1st To Bring in Town Debts & Credit —

2^d To See if the Town will provide a Grammar School next
year & order where the School shall be kept the insuing year
and Grant money for the support of the same —

3^d To See if the Town will Grant there Rev^d ministers
there Salary the year insuing —

4th To See if the Town will Grant money for the support of
Reading & writing School & order where the School shall
Be kept the year insuing —

5th To See if the Town will Grant money for the Relief
of the poor in said Town the present year —
