

- 6th To See if the Town will appoint a man or men to Take off & Sweep each of the meeting Houses in said Town the year ensuing, and Dig Graves as there may be Occasion
- 7th To See if the Town will Grant money to pay their Officers and Town Treasurer the present year -
- 8th To See if the Town will Acept of a plan of Twenty Acres of Land in the New Grant so that wide High way so Called, Taken by Sam^l. Brigham Sec^y. said Brighams Administratrix, Giving the Town proper Security for said Land, & Order the plan to be Recorded
- 9th To See if the Town will Grant or appropriate a suitable Sum of money to Build a work House in said Town & Order where said House shall be sett or do or act as the Town shall think proper when meet, agreeable to a Petition of Cornelias Wood & others -
- 10th To See if the Town will Discontinue that part of Lancaster old Road, from M^r. W^m. Mies House to the Northwest Corner of Capt. Elijah Smiths Land, or so far as said Road Runs in said Mies Land, & Chuse a Committee to See said Land to Jo Mies or any other person that shall appear to Buy said Land, agreeable to a Petition of Peter. Royce & others -
- 11th To See if the Town will Give Liberty to En^l. Josiah Richardson to put up Convenient Benches at the fore Side of the Body Seats, in the west Meeting House in said Town, for Boys to sit on on the Saboth -
- 12th To See if the Town will Grant a suitable Sum of money to enlarge the Town Stock of Ammunition -
- 13th To See if the Town will Grant a Sum of money to Carry on Dunn Cause -
- 14th To See if the Town will agree with M^r. Benj^a. Estabrook for so much of his Land as will make the County Road Leading to Stow a Convenient width, at the foot of the Hill Near said Estabrooks Barn -
