

- 5th To see if the Town will Give Liberty for the Swine to Go at Large in said Town the year Enowing
- 6th To see if the Town will Except of the List of Juries as put into the Box by the Selectmen
- 7th To see if the Town will Accept of an Alteration in the Road by En^d Duboz Duffers Agreeable to the Minutes Taken by the Selectmen
- 8th To see if the Town will Accept of a Highway as Laid out by the Selectmen through Lev^t. Daniel Noyes Land to the Farm belonging to the Heirs of Josiah Noyes Dec^d, and Give Liberty for Lev^t Daniel Noyes to hang a Gate across said way where it Runs through his Land also Order the Survers shall Repair said way at the Towns Cost out of the Highway Rate
- 9th To see if the Town will Chuse a Committee to Appear at Court to Oppose the Report of a Committee being Excepted, if they should Report in favour of the County Road being Laid through the Swamp from M^r Bridges to M^r Zechariah Bryants agreeable to the Petition of Joseph Rutter and Others
- 10th To see if the Town will Consent to Let Other Town Children have the Benefit of our School Or Otherwise to see the Towns mind in the Affair Agreeable to the Petition of Lev^t Joseph Smith and Others
- 11th To see if the Town will Build or Hire a work House the Present year or Do or act any other way as the Town shall think proper when met

And make Return of this Order with your Doings thereon to the Town Clerk or Selectmen at Time and place
