- 1<sup>st</sup> To Bring in Town Debt and Credit
- 2<sup>d</sup> To see if the Town will Provide a Gramer Schoolmaster  
and Order where the School shall be kept the Ensuing  
year and Grant money for the Support of the same
- 3<sup>d</sup> To see if the Town will Grant their Rev. Ministers  
there Sallery the year Ensuing
- 4<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Grant money for the Support  
of the Reading and writing School and Order when the School  
shall be kept the year Ensuing
- 5<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of  
the Poore the Present year
- 6<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Appoint a man or Men to Take Care  
off and sweep Each of the Meeting Houses in the Town the year  
Ensuing and Dig Graves as there may be Oration
- 7<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessors  
and Town Treasurer the Present year
- 8<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Grant money to make Addition to  
the Town Stock of Amunition
- 9<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Grant the money Allowd to Each  
of the Proprietors for the Land Taken from them by the  
Courts Com<sup>rs</sup> for a Road from the Rev. Mr. Josiah Bridges to  
the East Meetinghouse also from the west Meeting House  
to Store also to see if the Town will Grant a suitable Sum  
of money to Repair the same or Do or act any other way  
as the Town shall think proper when meet
- 10<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will Grant a suitable sum of money  
to Build a work House in the Town and provide Material to  
supply the same
