and Dig Graves as there may be occasion also Mr Josiah
Benhit to Do Like on the west side the river

8th it was Put to vote to see if the Town would Grant
to Mr Zachariah Bryant and Mr Tho: Carr the Damages
Allowed to them by the Courts Com^{tee} for Land Taken
from them for a Highway and past in the Negation

It was Put to vote to see if the Town would Chuse a Com^{tee}
to Petition the Court to Discontinue the New Road Laid
Out by the Courts Com^{tee} ~~from the~~ from the Road Mr
Josiah Bridges Throu the Swamps to the School House

and it Past in the Affirmation
Then the Town by their Vote Chose Maj: Joseph Carter
John Maynard and Mr Tho: Hynton to Draw a Petition
and to bring it to the Town at the Adjournment of
Meeting for their Approbation

Then the Town by their Vote Adjourned their Meeting
to next Monday Come Tenight to this place at One
O'Clock in the afternoon in Order to finish the
work of said meeting
