- 2^d To see if the Town will Give Liberty for Horses to Go at Large
without fetters any Part of the Time from the first of April
to the Last of November the year Ensuing
- 3^d To see if the Town will Repair their Highways by a Rate
the present year and Grant a suitable Sum of money for
Repairing the same and Impower the Surveyors to be Collectors
of said Rate also Order the Assessors to make it into a Rate
forthwith
- 4th To see if the Town will by their vote Give Liberty for Sheep
to Go at Large in said Town any part of the Time from the
fifteenth Day of March Next to the first Day of May Next
- 5th To see if the Town will Give Liberty for the Swine to Go at
Large in said Town the present year
- 6th To see if will Choose a Committee to Take Care of the Ministons
woodland on the East Side of the River and Prosecute any person
or persons that shall Cut any Trees or Carry off any wood from
said Lott without Leave first Obtained of Rev. Mr Bridge -
- 7th To see if the Town will Impower their Present Committee or
Choose a new One to wait on the Courts Committee when
when said Committee shall Come to Review the Alteration they
formerly made on the County Road from the East Meetinghouse
in Sudbury to Stow Line or Do or act any other way as the
Town shall think proper when meet
- 8th To see if the Town will Build or Hire a work House in
Town the year Ensuing
