Then the Town by their vote Chose John Noyes Esq. for their Moderator

- Ar. 2. it was Put to vote to see if the Town will Build a workhouse the present year and it past in the Negation
Then the Town by their vote Impowered the Overseers of the Poore to Hire a workhouse the present year
- 3rd The Town by their vote Ordered the Selectmen to Repair the windows in each of the meetinghouses in said Town
Then the Town by their vote Disolved their meeting

These Order you to warn all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants off and belonging to Sudbury (in your ward) Quallified as the Law Directs to vote in Town Affairs to Meet at the East Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the sixteenth Day of October Currant at One O'Clock in the Afternoon on said Day then and their

- 1st To bring in Town Debt and Credit
- 2^d To see if the Town will Grant their Rev. Ministers their Salary the year ensuing
- 3^d To see if the Town will Provide a Gramer Schoolmaster and Order where the School shall be kept the year ensuing and Grant money for the support of the same
- 4th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the support of the Reading and writing School and Order where the School shall be kept the year ensuing
- 5th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Relief of the Poore in said Town the year ensuing
