7th To see if the Town will Grant money to Pay their Assessors and Town Treasurer the Present year

8th To see if the Town will Comply with the Request of Mr Ashen Cutter in Taking and Supporting Capt John Haynes for the future or Do or Act any Other way as the Town shall think Proper when Meet

9th To see if the Town will Comply with the Request of the Overseers in Taking and Supporting Moses Hayden for the future or Do or Act any Other way as the Town shall think Proper when Meet

10th To see if the Town will Grant a suitable Sum of money to Make the Road Sately Laid out by from the Red on Josiah Bridges to the School House near the East Meeting House or Do or Act any Other way as the Town shall think Proper when Meet

11th To see if the Town will Choose a Committee and fully Impower them to Take Care of the new Grants 30 Rod Highways so Called and fully Impower them to Prosecute any Person or Persons that shall Cut any Trees or Carry off any wood or Timber from said ways or Do or Act any Other way as the Town shall think Proper when Meet

12th To see if the Town will Grant a suitable Sum of money to Carry on Dunns Cause or Do or Act any Other way as the Town shall think proper when Meet
